FOR STUDY

Affordable Housing Study Group proposes to research the subject of affordable housing: what it is, who it serves, and the government and non-government agencies involved in policy decisions and implementation. The local League has no current position about affordable housing.

Education Study Group proposes to review the local League's current Education position, last amended in 1999, to determine if it is adequate and reflects the current situation in the Las Cruces Public School District. In addition, points of interest (e.g., funding, curriculum, educational structure, to name a few) were identified for inclusion in this study.

ONGOING PROGRAM STUDIES AND COMMITTEES

(Advocacy action will be taken on these as the opportunity presents itself.)

Branigan Library: To advocate for branch libraries and consolidation of resources into a regional library system

Election Procedure/Voter Turnout: To improve the election process and encourage voter turnout.

Mental Illness Services in Doña Ana County: To identify the type of services needed for individuals with mental illness.

Metropolitan Court for Dona Ana County: To advocate for the establishment of a court and educate members of the community and elected officials about this issue.

Solid Waste Recycling: To advocate for all inclusive trash disposal and readily accessible recycling for all county residents, as well as to provide public education.
